Subject: Invitation and book chapter in the framework of the Bootcamp.

Within the framework of the Bootcamp is the initiative to publish a book, with a tentative title of:

**" Building the future of education together:
innovation, interdisciplinary research and open science"**

It is invited to produce and disseminate unpublished, disciplinary or interdisciplinary research, with contributions for the future of Education. Studies on the frontiers of knowledge of education are of interest, especially within the framework of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (e.g. justice and peace, water or sustainable energy), provided that this research has a clear educational dimension or a connection with the frontier of knowledge.

It will be an electronic open book, edited with a publisher within the SPI-CSIC in the 2 levels of greater editorial prestige, which will publish the chapters of the participants. The book will be aimed at academic communities, business training, corporate universities, etc. so the writing should focus on a wide audience.

The different proposals of the chapters will be evaluated by the editors of the book, in order to verify that they are aligned with the objectives we have to publish it. Proposals will go through evaluations by editors and invited experts.

If you agree to participate in this call, this will imply compliance with a set of requirements (dates, chapter structure, extension of sections, etc.) that are attached to this invitation. In addition, for the purpose of publishing the book, you will be asked at the time to sign a letter in which you acknowledge that the content of the chapter is of your original authorship and that you assign the economic rights of your writing for incorporation into the book. It is required that the authors of the chapter are registered in the Bootcamp.

We believe that this opportunity to publish a chapter in this book will add value to his professional career and allow him to make his ideas known even more among those who make up the educational community. We also consider it an opportunity to bond by writing in co-authorship with colleagues from different research groups or other universities. Pending a favorable response, we send you a cordial greeting.

***Structure for the sections of the chapter:**

Section	Description
Title	Creative title, no more than 12 words, to capture the reader's attention. You must bring a colon and after the dots indicate the method.
Data of the author (or authors)	Full name of the author(s) Affiliation (in the case of Tec it would be: Tecnológico de Monterrey) Email
Summary	Make sure your chapter contains a summary of between 150 and 200 words that indicates, in a single paragraph, what you will find in the chapter: con the attractive topic sentence. Question/objective. Method with method name, instruments, population, type of analysis. Findings numbered (a), (b), (c), (d). Differential value for educational communities, society, decision makers.
Epigraph	An epigraph is a famous quote or phrase, alluding to the topic, with which the chapter opens. Check that it has between two and five lines (no more). Indicate the author of the citation.
Introduction	Introductory text that is really creative to capture the reader's attention, that talks about the topic, states the objective of the chapter and states the structure of the chapter. Two or three paragraphs are suggested, indicating in the last paragraph the differential value for the future of education and the link with the sustainable development goals.
Structure	<p>The structure of the content of the chapter depends on each author and the theme of each chapter, but it is recommended that the chapters include the sections of scientific research writings, contributing to the future of education and the link with the sustainable development goals.</p> <p>Theoretical framework Method Results Discussion</p> <p>These points are not necessarily section headings of the chapter. Each author must decide how he is going to structure it.</p> <p>It should also be taken into account that this book will be aimed at academic communities, business training, corporate universities, etc. so the writing should focus on a wide audience.</p>
Conclusion	<p>Let the conclusion be with an inspiring closing of the chapter with a reflection that invites the reader to delve deeper into this area. Three paragraphs are recommended:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Answer to question or objective, with a, b, c, d (more expanded than in the abstract) • Implications for practice and research (contributing to the future of education and linking to the Sustainable Development Goals) • Limitations and future studies
References	<p>Include between 15 and 25 references to important writings that speak of the area (try to cite people recognized in the area and, as far as possible, recent references (from 2017 to date). References must be written according to APA manual guidelines. It is also necessary to check very well that everything that has been cited in the body of the chapter is in the references and, vice versa, everything that appears in the references section is because it was cited throughout the chapter. Check the validity of each and every one of the leagues.</p>

Self-citation	Related to the previous point, be careful not to abuse self-citation (the authors of the chapters cite their own work). If you are going to cite your work, make sure that the number of citations and references does not exceed three documents and that they are related to the content of the chapter.
About the authors	At the end of each chapter, comes a section titled "About the Author" or "About the Authors." Please check that the full names of the authors of the chapter come. The email address should also come. Subsequently, there should be a single paragraph in which each author is spoken in the third person, and citing their schooling, work experience, current work and lines of research (between 200 and 300 words).
Figures and Tables	In case of integrating Figures and / or Tables, we require them in editable format, since this will be requested by the publisher (this is important, for example, to change the typography, and this cannot be done in still images). In the case of including photographs or screen prints, it is required that they be with the highest possible resolution (preferably TIF format or, failing that, JPG). Please send in a zip folder the images of your chapters, numbered according to the writing.
Style review	Use an even writing style. It is recommended to use third-person or impersonal wording.

Recommendations for the writing and physical presentation of the brief:

- All authors of a chapter should review the guidelines established in this document and the writing of the writing, before making submissions.
- It is very important to respect the basic structure of each chapter.
- The writing must have an average length of not less than 8 pages and not more than 10 pages, including references and annexes (if they exist).
- The writing must be done in Word.
- The sheet shall be configured in such a way that it has 3 cm of left margin and 2.5 cm of right, upper and lower margins.
- The chapter should be written double-spaced, using Arial 10 font.
- The way of citing and writing the references should follow the canons of the *Manual of publications of the American Psychological Association*.
- It is advisable to include Tables, Figures or other information organizers that allow illustrating a topic. These must be of his authorship; and should be placed in editable format. It is recommended NOT to include Tables or Figures that require copyright, as this can greatly prolong the publication of the book. Only in the case in which the author already has written authorization from the author / publisher to use a table or figure, and delivers it at the time of submitting the chapter, its inclusion can be accepted.
- It is recommended that the chapter be written in black and white. If Tables or Figures are included, avoid using colors. This recommendation is made in the event that the book is to be published on paper and so as not to increase the cost of production and, consequently, the price of the book itself.

Evaluation criteria

Content criteria:

Unprecedented research contributing to the future of education. Studies on the frontiers of knowledge of education (or related areas, but linked to Education). Research related to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. Studies with a clear educational dimension or a connection with the frontier of knowledge.

Criteria for training:

Writings that comply with the indicated template. Integration of updated references (2017 to date) and taking care of the requested format, with a scientific and academic writing for a wide audience.
